

# LES GROUPES DE RÉFORME SOCIALE PARRAINÉS PAR L'ÉGLISE DE SCIENTOLOGIE

Les découvertes issues des recherches de Ron Hubbard ont un champ d'application très large dans la société, allant de la réhabilitation des toxicomanes à l'amélioration de l'éducation.

Les principales associations laïques utilisant les méthodes mises au point par Ron Hubbard se consacrent à des programmes caritatifs d'amélioration sociale :

- **Narconon** : programme de prévention anti-drogue et de réhabilitation des toxicomanes;
- **Applied Scholastics** : programme destiné à éradiquer l'illettrisme et à favoriser une meilleure éducation;
- **Criminon** : programme de réhabilitation des délinquants ;
- **La Fondation du Chemin du Bonheur** : programme de restauration des valeurs morales dans la société, fondé sur la distribution d'un code moral non religieux écrit par Ron Hubbard, *Le Chemin du Bonheur*.

Chacune de ces associations est une organisation internationale indépendante à but non lucratif. Elles utilisent les découvertes et les méthodes de Ron Hubbard pour l'amélioration sociale. Les scientologues soutiennent ces programmes caritatifs.

Ces organisations sont décrites de manière détaillée dans le livre de référence *Qu'est-ce que la Scientologie ?* publié par l'éditeur New Era. Aux États-Unis, elles ont fait l'objet d'un examen approfondi par l'administration fiscale qui les a déclarées associations caritatives authentiques aidant à l'amélioration sociale. A ce titre elles ont été exonérées d'impôts.

PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY  
NOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

on ending the use of the drug methadone  
presented by Mr Ruffly and others

The Assembly.

1. Considering that, in accordance with article 15 of the United Nations Conference to consider Amendments to the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, 1961, all practical measures should be taken to assist persons whose work so requires to gain an understanding of the problems of abuse of drugs and of its prevention, and should also promote such understanding among the general public if there is a risk that abuse of drugs will become widespread;
2. Convinced of the fact that drugs need to be combated as they are enslaving many individuals in our society today, and that the abuse thereof often results in untimely deaths of the victims and untold sorrow in their families;
3. Observing that in member countries psychiatrists are administering methadone via private medical doctors and directly to drug addicts as an acceptable solution for their addiction;
4. Observing that numerous international scientific studies on the subject of methadone have shown that this artificial drug has more harmful effects on addicted individuals than the dreadful heroin, making it for example three times as hard to end addiction to methadone as to heroin;
5. Considering that currently in member countries methadone, as well as being legally distributed, is legally sold by drug dealers in the streets as a hard drug, to make profit;



**RÉHABILITATION DES CRIMINELS**



**W**EST COVINA — Gilbert Soto never dreamed that getting caught driving without a license for the 10th time would lead him to a critical self-examination and eventually turn his life around.

The Baldwin Park resident — who has tattoos illustrating his life up and down his arms and legs — has a lengthy criminal record. At 10, he hot-wired a Monte Carlo and went for a joy ride. At 11, he started using speed. At 12, he ended up in prison.

Soto spent time in Chino, Soledad and Folsom state prisons. By the time he was finally released at about the age of 20, he was an angry and bitter young man.

"When you get out of prison, you're like a lion from hell," Soto, 43, said this week while stitching fabric on a chair at Mike Factory, a custom-design furniture

company in Pico Rivera, where he has worked since 1984.
